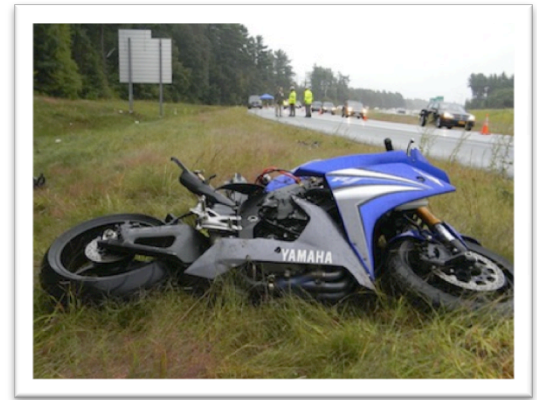

- P- Prevent** Further Injuries – secure the scene, personal precautions, bike lift, when and how to move the injured
- A- Assess** the Situation- possible injuries, mechanisms of injury
- C- Contact** the EMS – how to give good information that gets proper help coming
- T- Treat** the injured with life sustaining care – ABCSS of trauma – Jaw thrust rescue breathing, when and how to remove a helmet, how to address external and internal bleeding and priority
